

## How does the Council combat illegal dumping?

When people discard their rubbish down a bank or into a creek or on the roadside - that really is illegal dumping. As well as environmental damage it detracts from the beauty of our District. A large portion of this waste could be recycled for free. It costs the ratepayer, because the Council must meet the expense of rubbish removal, follow up complaints, and prosecute people for illegal dumping. Illegal dumping is a community problem that can only be properly addressed by the community working in partnership with the Council - the Council can help the community if the community is prepared to help the Council.

Council staff will want to know:

- Where the rubbish has been dumped?
- Whether it is dangerous and presents a potential health hazard, e.g. chemicals or broken glass?
- Who do you suspect may have dumped the rubbish?

A reward of \$500 may be offered for information leading to the successful prosecution of any person caught dumping illegally. Illegal dumping is an offence under the Litter Act 1979, with offenders liable for fines of up to \$5,000 for each offence.

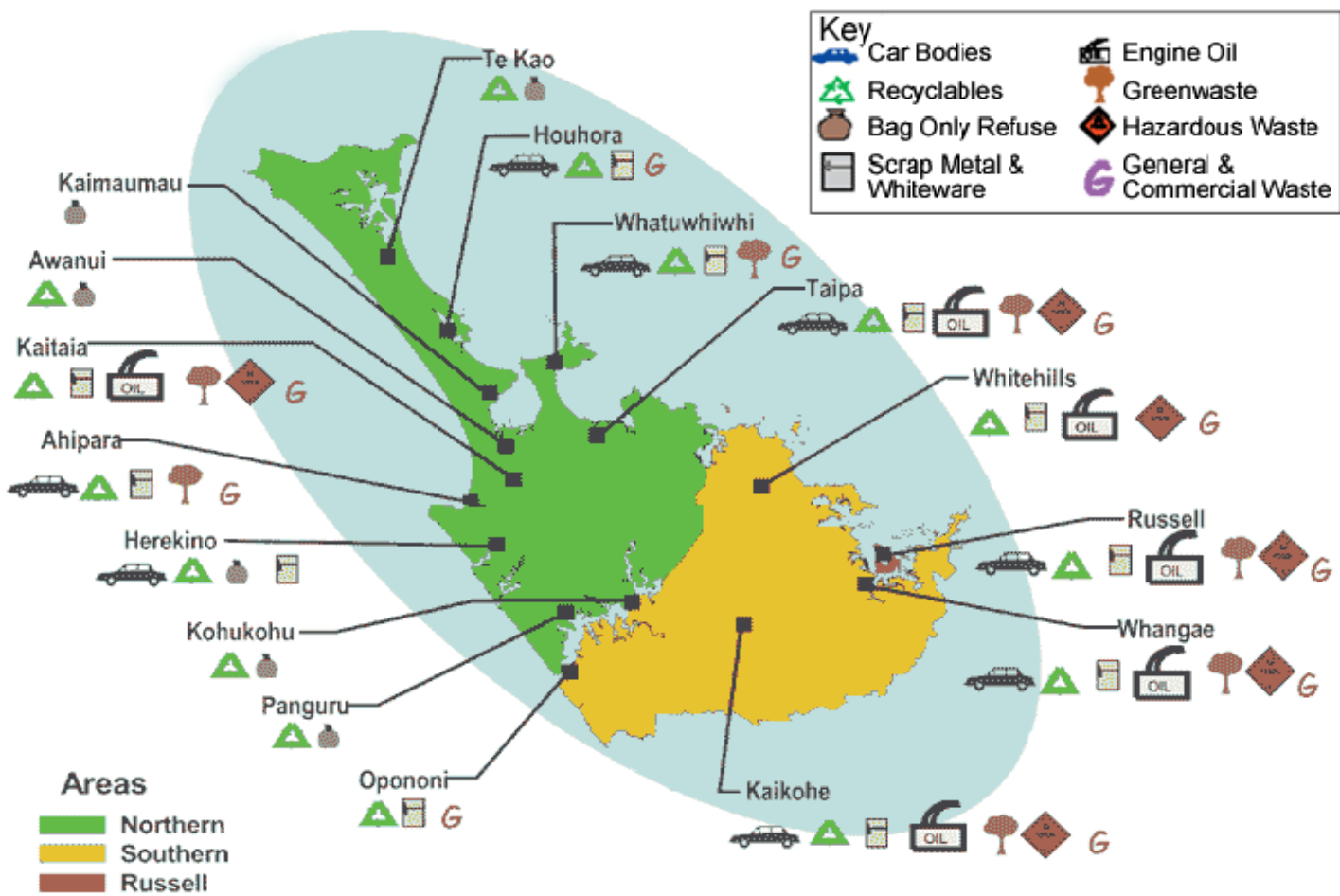
