Far North District Licensing Committee Practice Note 6 Status of Objectors



Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Date: 1 May 2023

From time to time, the status of an objector and the grounds of the objection are challenged by an applicant.

Once an objection is received the matter should be referred to the chairperson of the Committee either as part of the inspector's report on the application, or in a separate report dealing only with the status of the objector/s and/or the grounds of the objection.

The chairperson can choose to either make a decision on the matters at the beginning of the hearing or on the papers prior to the hearing.

As a general rule the Committee asks itself will the objector be affected in some way by the operation of the proposed premises. They may live, or work, or visit the area on a regular basis and this may establish a greater interest than the public at large.

It will be up to the DLC to determine and grant/deny status to potential objectors that wish to be heard on an application.
