Ngā whāinga | Purpose

To provide Elected Members with an update on the delayed adoption of the Annual Report 21/22 due to the treatment of a prior year adjustment.

Horopaki | Context

The Annual Report for 21/22 was to be adopted this week on the 9^{th} of March 2023 Council meeting. This will now go to the Council meeting on the 23^{rd} of March 2023.

Audit has identified an amendment of treatment of grants in relation to Far North Holdings Limited (FNHL) that requires a prior year adjustment.

Due to the timing and process this will change the Group figures in the report.

Ngā korerorero | Discussion

There will be a delay to the adoption of the Annual Report 21/22.

Audit has identified an amendment in the treatment of grants relating to FNHL. This requires a prior year adjustment that needs technical clearance from the Office of the Auditor-General (OAG).

It will take a few days to work through the process as there are a number of additional steps required.

This will only affect the Group numbers.
