In 2018 (Stats NZ) our population recorded 1,602 people of whom 58.2% are of Maori and 54.1% European descent. Some 700 people aged 15 years plus are employed as managers (21.9%), labourers (30.6%), professionals, technicians and trade workers, machine operators and drivers, clerical, admin, sales, community and personal service workers range from 4 to 10%.
