## **Event Waste Management and Minimisation Plan**

Event organisers are required to ensure the responsible disposal of waste produced by and associated with their event. This usually requires the engagement of a licenced waste collector to collect and dispose of the waste.

Organisers are expected to maximise the collection and use of recyclables and re-usable material and to minimise the amount of waste going to Landfill.
