



North Area Maintenance Network Contract Monthly Report October 2025

Summary

October has been another busy month, ramping into a wide range of contract activities. Pre-reseal repairs are tracking well with lots of pre-reseal pavement repairs and water tabling of reseal sites now complete, this has allowed us to make good gains in early delivery of some of our reseals this month. We have also started on a network spray round this month and have been completing a large water tabling job on Rakautapu Rd / Paponga Rd, which is ongoing.

The cover photo is of our new 2025 cadets. After completing an intensive training 4 week training programme with our Infrastructure Skills Centre (ISC) trainer Jon Catt, our 5 new cadets graduate this Friday then will be out with our work crews next week. This programme is an awesome initiative in which we partner with the Ministry of Social Development to help people who are struggling to gain employment opportunities. Works on our first Rehab for the season, Hihi Rd, is progressing well. The photo below shows FNR trucks helping to complete the metal overlay. We are stabilising this job on the 4th of November and have also started works on the second section on Hihi Rd that we are also rehabilitating this season.

1 October 2025 Partnering with Northland's employers for success

Social Development and Employment

The Ministry for Social Development is successfully partnering with local businesses to get Northland job seekers into work.

Whangarei employers have joined Minister of Social Development and Employment Louise Upston at an Into Work event, sharing their experiences of successfully filling multiple vacancies in their businesses.

One successful example is Fulton Hogan who have been working with MSD, investing local communities by training and employing 44 MSD clients. These cadets undergo a structured learning programme aimed at acquiring essential skills and knowledge in a particular job role or industry.

"Fulton Hogan are among those providing opportunities for job seekers, placing more people in Northland than anywhere else in the country." Louise Upston says.

"MSD is making sure it really understands a business so it can link employers with local job seekers who are the right fit for local jobs.

"We know that 76 per cent of people receiving Jobseeker Support in Northland (who have been on benefit for less than a year) already have previous work experience and with MSD's team guiding the process, they're being linked with employers and real jobs."


Whangarei's Into Work event is the fifth Louise Upston has attended across New Zealand, bringing MSD employment teams together with local employers with more locations to come.

"These are opportunities for local employers and organisations to discuss how we can all work together to understand workforce needs and address workforce challenges." Louise Upston says.

Programme Completion

Our Archimedes dashboard below shows our programme completion for the month of October. Out of the 531 dispatches that were presented to the programme on the 15th of September, 450 have been completed, as result of 84.75% complete.

Key programme achievements include Vegetation Spraying, Stabilised patches, watertabling and the first of our reseal sites.



Works Programme

A total of **1,401** work items were completed this month. This included **808** routine jobs with the remainder being cyclic, emergency works or call outs and ordered works or programmed jobs.

Routine Works Completed

The routine works completed included the following:

- Grading was completed on **46** roads this month. A length of **187** km was graded, which is **22.7**% of our 823km unsealed network length
- Metalling was completed on **3** roads, with **1061** m3 of metal applied.
- Potholing was completed on **70** roads, with **407** jobs completed. **3,219** total unsealed and sealed potholes were completed this month.
- Roadside mowing was completed on **42** roads this month.
- **6** Emergency works / Callouts completed this month included call outs to road damage by third parties, underslips, trees down and an overslip.

Aggregate Usage

The following maintenance aggregate was used during October. This is the equivalent of **178** truck loads of metal:

- GAP 30 / 40 1,097 m3
- GAP 65 152 m3

Cyclic Works Completed

- A full network line mark was completed during 2024/25.
- A full network spray round commenced this month.

Drainage Maintenance and Renewals

- 62 cesspit grates were cleared
- 0 culvert markers were replaced
- 19 culvert ends were cleared
- 0 cesspits were flushed
- 8 culverts were flushed
- **75** m of culvert pipes were replaced
- Channel hand clearing was completed on 2 roads
- 15km of water tables were cleared

Road Furniture Activities

- 35 signs posts were replaced
- 13 posts were painted
- 71 signs were replaced
- 12 signs were straightened
- 5 signs were cleaned
- 11 signs had vegetation cleared around
- 0 bridge edge markers were cleaned and 4 were replaced
- 21 edge markers were replaced and 1 were straightened

Structures Maintenance

- 21 bridge deck/drain holes were cleared
- 2 bridges were painted
- **0** bridges had vegetation clearance completed

Footpath Maintenance

- 4 footpath vegetation clearance jobs completed
- 2 footpath premix temp footpath failure repairs completed
- 1 footpath sweeping/water blasting debris jobs completed






<u>Pawarenga Rd – Stabilising Repairs in Progress</u>



<u>Taipa Heights Rd – Digout Repair in Progress</u>




