Almost two-thirds of the Far North District's 2508km road network is unsealed. The Council doesn't have the funds to seal all unsealed roads, so we seal sections of a small number of our busiest, most densely populated roads to reduce the harmful impacts that dust has on nearby residents.



Sealing sections of road near homes and public facilities reduces the harmful impacts dust has on people's health.

We are sealing 9.4 km of seven roads in the district over the next three years under our Priority Seal Extensions Programme which is funded entirely by rates. Staff selected the sections of road for sealing against 22 criteria, including traffic volumes, resident numbers and distances between homes and roads.

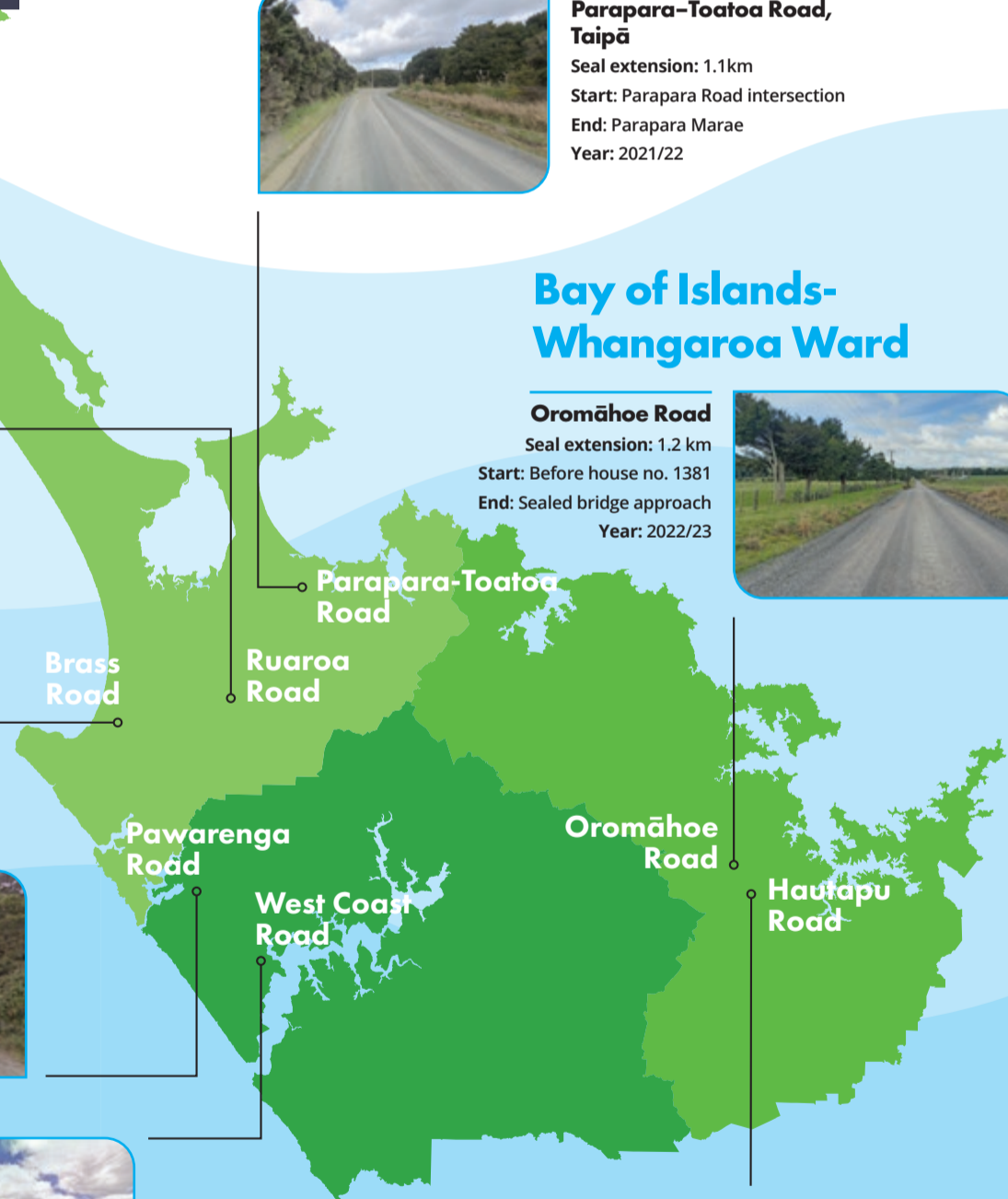
