Almost two-thirds of the Far North District's 2508km road network is unsealed. The Council doesn't have the funds to seal all unsealed roads, so we seal sections of a small number of our busiest roads each year. These are roads that link a high number of homes, schools, marae and other public facilities.



Most sealing work on Council roads is undertaken during warmer weather between November and May.

We are sealing 23.3km of six, high-priority roads in the district this year with funding assistance from Waka Kotahi NZ Transport Agency, the Provincial Growth Fund and the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment's Tourism Infrastructure Fund.
