Russell	Long Beach	Trading permitted with a Site Permit. Only, for the car park area	Only exemption will be to short term traders such as mobile ice cream vendors (e.g. Mr Whippy) – maximum of 60 minutes trading at any one location
		No trading on The Strand, Russell	Exemptions may be given by Council for special events, particularly if the road is closed for such events.
	Tapeka Point	No Trading at Sandy Beach	Only exemption will be to short term traders such as mobile ice cream vendors (e.g. Mr Whippy) – maximum of 60 minutes trading at any one location
Paihia	Marsden Road	No trading on Marsden Road, Paihia, between the Bluff through to School Road, inclusive of all reserves	Exemptions may be given to Tour Operators, at the Maritime Building, for the periods covering the arrival of Cruise liners, with conditions* * see 'Tour Operators Conditions' below.
	Marsden Road	Trading permitted with a Site Permit only, between School Road and Seaview Road	Only exemption will be to short term traders such as mobile ice cream vendors (e.g. Mr Whippy) – maximum of 60 minutes trading at any one location
	Marsden Rd, Te Tii Beach	Trading permitted between the roundabout on junction of Puketona Rd and Marsden Rd, through to the Bluff, under a Site Permit only.	Jet Ski lane is for public use only. Only exemption to a Site Permit will be to short term traders such as mobile ice cream vendors (e.g. Mr Whippy) – maximum of 60 minutes trading at any one location. These will be covered by a Mobile Shop licence.
	Te Karuwha Parade	Trading permitted with a Site Permit only. Includes All jet ski or beach activity operations (e.g. Parachutist etc) permitted in the Northland Regional Council defined areas (e.g. Jet ski lanes etc)	Only exemption will be to short term traders such as mobile ice cream vendors (e.g. Mr Whippy) – maximum of 60 minutes trading at any one location. These will be covered by a Mobile Shop licence.
	Memorial Hall, Williams Road	No trading permitted directly outside of the Memorial Hall on public land	No exemptions

NOTE: These restrictions do not apply to any operator who has a Licence to Occupy from the Council (e.g. Kayak operator etc)

Definition

Site Permit – means a permit issued to occupy a specific space on a daily basis, for the duration of the permit, which will be subject to conditions.(see below)

Tour Operators – means any operator of a bus, mini-bus or similar passenger carrying vehicle wishing to sell tours or trips to interested customers on those days when cruise liners visit the Bay of Islands, as detailed in the “Expected Arrivals, Bay Of Islands, Piloting to Anchorage” annual schedule.

Site Permit Conditions

The following conditions shall apply to a Site Permit, but not be limited to the conditions defined below:-

- A Site Permit allows the holder the use of one parking spaces only, within the defined area indicated on the Permit
- The Permit holder must not block any parking space at the end of the trading day, but must secure a parking space within the defined area on arrival each day.
- The Permit holder must provide a litter bin and ensure that any associated litter is removed on a daily basis. Litter must not be placed in a public litter bin.

Tour Operators Conditions

The following conditions shall apply to Tour Operators, but not be limited to the conditions defined below:-

- All operators shall obtain a licence from the Council and pay the appropriate fee before commencing trading.
- No Operator shall park their vehicle (tour bus, people carrier etc) in any other location than a clearly defined parking space.
- The vehicle shall not occupy 2 or more parking spaces.
- The vehicle may only remain in the parking space for the permitted time (e.g. 60 minutes (P60))
- All tour operators are only permitted to have one standard size, removable advertising sign (see clause 3206.1(h) of Chapter 32, Control of the Use of Public Places bylaw.
- All advertising signs shall be removed when the sale of tour trips are not taking place.
- Tour operator shall remove any litter associated with the operations (e.g. Tickets stubs etc)
- The operator shall not use any amplified equipment, megaphone or similar device to advertise tour rides.
